## SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT

Idsall School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all students and expects all staff, volunteers and visitors to share this commitment.

**Child Protection is everybody's responsibility and all people in the school community have a duty to act on any concern.**

If you are concerned about the safety of any student in our school, you must report this to one of the designated Safeguarding staff – Ms C Cork, Mrs J Reeve, Mr A Baldwin and Mrs H Lynn.

If you are concerned about the conduct of a member of staff or a volunteer in our school, you must contact the Headteacher, Mr P. Bourton.

All members of staff wear an identity badge and visitors are also required to wear a badge. This allows the staff, students and parents to know who the adults are in the school, ensuring that everyone feels safe.

Photographs must not be taken (or recordings made) whilst on site unless authorised by the school.

### Visitors Procedures

- All visitors **must sign in** at Main Reception
- All visitors will be issued with an appropriate badge which must be displayed at all times whilst on site
- Visitors will be asked to remain under the supervision of a designated member of staff whilst on site
- Visitors wishing to speak to a particular member of staff should telephone the school to make an appointment, when possible, to avoid disappointment – if you are seeking an urgent appointment, please report to the Main Reception
- All visitors **must sign out** at the Main Reception and return their visitors badge before leaving the site
