Natural Forms

- Your coursework project will be on Natural forms - Have a go at drawing as many natural forms as you can think of e.g; Flowers, fruit (cut up), Veg, shells, plants, leaves, bones and animals. The more you do the better your coursework and drawing will be.
- Take as many photographs as you can - again of lots of different kinds of Natural Forms
- Research artists and photographers that look at Natural forms, try; Kate Malone, Gus Harper, Andy Goldsworthy, Anthony Gormley, Katie Hough, and Botanical artists such as Elizabeth Blackadder.
- Try to visit as many galleries as possible as you will be able to include your findings in your coursework.

You might want to consider purchasing the following to help you with your work...

- A range of Pencils - HB, H, B, 2B, 4B
- Good blendable Pencil crayons and or Watercolour Pencil Crayons
- Small set of Acrylic paints and possibly Oil Paints
- Range of brushes
- Pritt Stick
- Good quality rubber and or putty rubber
