The Law now states that all current Year 11s will be required to remain in education or training until their 18th birthday.

This does not mean you have to stay in school.

However, it does mean you will have to consider doing one of the 3 options below....

Options after finishing school

Apprenticeships & Traineeships

You will usually be working 4 days per week with an employer and 1 day per week working towards a qualification in a relevant subject at a college or training centre.

Alternatively undertake work experience as part of a Traineeship

- Training Provider:

Go on a training programme, which can help you find work, Apprenticeship or Traineeship

Employment

You can undertake part time education or training combined with being employed, self-employed or volunteering 20 hours or more a week.
