Dear Parents and Carers

On **Friday 10th December**, we will be taking part in **Save the Children's Christmas Jumper Day**. We're asking families to donate £1 (or however much they can give), to support children in the UK and around the world. By taking part we'll be helping kids who don't have the basics they need to survive – like food, school or medicine – to start seeing the magic in the world again.

Students are invited to wear a Christmas Jumper instead of their school blazer – the rest of the school uniform should be worn as normal. We expect students to be sensible in their choice of jumper, and dress in a way that is appropriate for the day's lessons and which will not cause offence or endanger themselves or others at school.

There's no need to buy a new jumper – students can decorate an existing top with some tinsel, or other Christmas themed decorations. If you want to get crafty at home, there will also be decorating templates available on the Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day Gameplan at christmasjumperday.org from mid-November.
