DAY ONE

FRIDAY 22ND MARCH 2024

04.00	Coach arrives at Idsall
04.30	Coach departs Idsall
10.00	Arrive at Dover (there will be a service station stop on the way to Dover)
12.00	Ferry Crossing
14.30	Arrive at Calais
19.00	Arrive at accommodation and check in
20.30	Short walk to restaurant for evening meal



Return to hotel for bed and sleep

DAY TWO

SATURDAY 23RD MARCH 2024

- 07.00 Breakfast at the accommodation
- 08.00 Coach travel to Disneyland Paris for a full day
The ticket gives group access to both the main Disneyland Park and Walt Disney Studios.
Marne Le Vallee is about 28.5 km from Disneyland (around half hour travel)
A meal voucher will be given to all students to get an evening meal

21.00 Meet the coach to transfer back to the accommodation

15.30	Ferry Crossing

All-you-can-eat breakfast buffet and free WiFi.



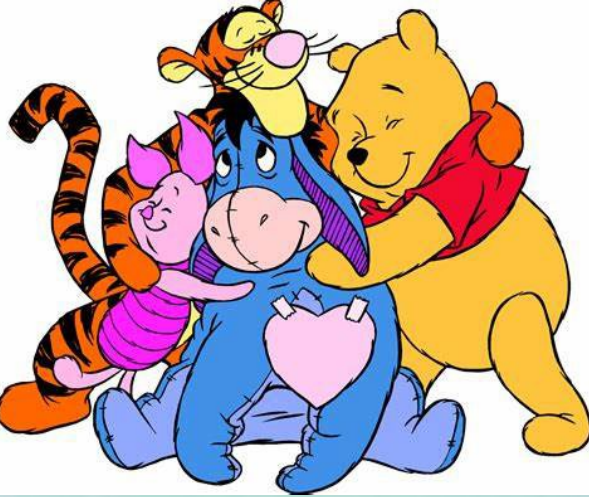
STUDENTS

The Day in Disneyland

Students will be allowed to go off in groups of 4 once we are all in Disneyland. They will have access to both parks and Disney Village

THE PARKS



WHAT IS INCLUDED

- 2 x 70 seater coaches with 1 driver per coach (TV/DVD/Video, WC)
- Return Channel Crossings
- Accommodation for 2 nights' bed and breakfast (multi-bedded rooms all rooms en-suite)
- Evening meal included on the day of arrival
- A meal voucher to be used for evening meal in Disneyland
- Disneyland Paris 2 parks/1 day ticket – this includes the cost of all the rides / parades etc
- A packed lunch on day 3
- Detailed Information Pack with relevant maps and visit confirmations
- Access to VAMOOS – our easy to use Travel App
- Comprehensive Travel and Medical Insurance
- Motorway tolls and taxes
- VAT at current rates to Tour Operators



OTHER COSTS TO CONSIDER

- Spending Money both UK and Euro
- Service station stops in both UK and France – include meals on Friday as we travel (breakfast and lunch). Lunch in Disneyland on the Saturday and meal on the return travel. Breakfast before we leave the hotel and a packed lunch will be issued to every student but they may require more in the evening as we travel.

COST

- The cost of the trip is £460 per student
- We have access to take maximum of 118 students
- Deposit of £60 per paying passenger by Wednesday 18th October
- 2nd Deposit of 50% of tour price (minus 1st deposit amount) payable by 1st December (£200)
- Final Payment 12th January (£200)

Note : Any damage to rooms caused by your student will be invoiced to you

Important Info

Travelling to the EU

Travelling to the EU, Iceland, Switzerland, Norway or Liechtenstein? Please take note of the following.

Passport Validity

British passport holders

We recommend that on the day you travel, all UK passports be less than 10 years old and have at least 6 months' validity remaining. This allows for travelling in Europe for up to 3 months. The requirement of most European countries is to have at least 3 months left on your passport on the day you leave.

Please check the [FCDO website](#) for the most up-to-date information on passport validity requirements.

If travelling to Ireland, your passport only needs to be valid for the duration of your stay.

Group Passports

Group or collective passports can still be arranged, although the number of European countries that accept them is now very limited.

For the most up-to-date information on which countries accept collective passports, please see the government's website.

Healthcare

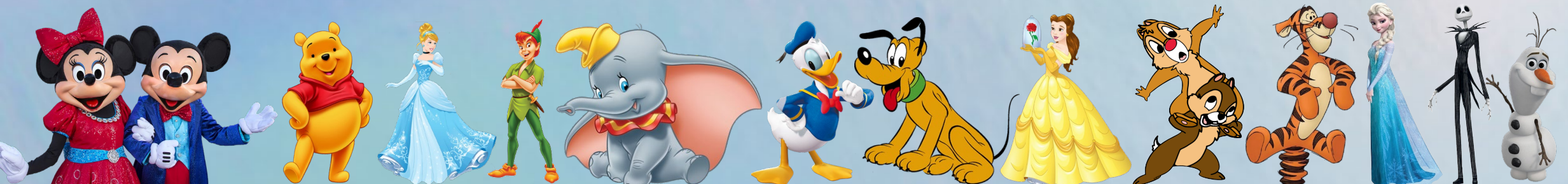
EHICs remain valid until their expiry date. If you do not have an EHIC or it has expired, you will need to apply for a GHIC through the [NHS website](#).



PASSPORTS

British Passport Holders

It is recommended that on the day we travel, all UK passports are less than 10 years old and have at least 6 months validity remaining. The requirement of most European countries is to have at least 3 months left on the day you leave.



EHIC / GHIC

EHIC cards remain valid until their expiry date.

If you do not have an EHIC or it has expired, you will need to apply for a GHIC through the [NHS Website](#).

These are free of charge but essential for a students to travel.
