Zakat ~ Giving 2.5% of your wealth to charity each year. 4. Saum / Sawm ~ Fasting in the Muslim month of Ramadan. 5. Hajj ~ Visiting Mecca, Saudi Arabia, once in your lifetime.





"I felt that some rules were too restrictive and needed thinking through. Let me thinking through an example. It's give you an example to do with the 4th commandment."

For strict Jews, 'keeping the Sabbath holy' means NO WORK. You can't cook, light a fire or harvest food. It was the Sabbath and my disciples and I were walking through a corn field; they were hungry and started to pick ears of corn to eat. They were accused by the teachers of the law of working!

So, I replied "If one of you has a child or an ox that falls into a well on the Sabbath day, will you not immediately pull it out?" The teachers of the Law went away.
