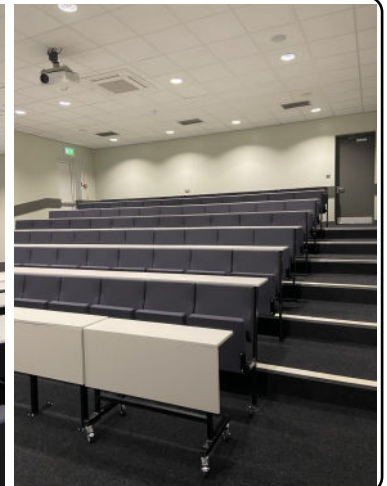
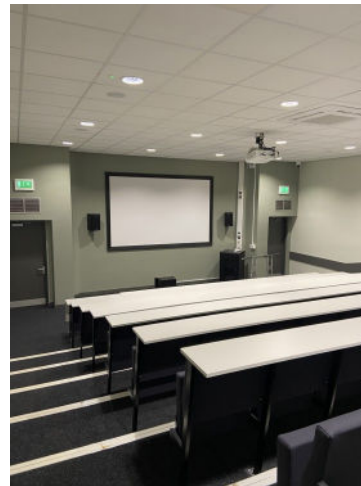
FOCUS Lecture Theatre Revamp
